Proverbs 27:17 Spiritual brothers or sisters

Purpose Sharpening, Encouragement, Growth

Format

DGroups: 3-5 small group of same gender, within the LG

MENTORING

2 Timothy 2:2 Spiritual fathers or mothers, older brothers or sisters

Purpose Spiritual mentoring & input

Format Varies. Usually outside of LG structure

DISCIPLESHIP TO JESUS

EVANGELISTIC

Matthew 28:19-20 1-3 people in your sphere of influence

Purpose

Inviting people to come see and know Jesus

Format

1-1 or small group

INTENSIVE

Hebrews 12:1-2 Structured training or learning opportunity

Purpose Growing through a focused seasonal experience

Format ADS, Growth Courses
